Goal

Effective development of the company through the efficient functioning of the organization. Preparing the company for changes in logistics; indicating priorities and directions of activities so that the company adapts the management system and efficiency to market challenges after the covid-19 pandemic.

Range

Implementation of a quick audit of Stalgast logistics experts in order to assess and recommend actions and priority changes along with their roadmap.

Results

- 13 recommended changes in areas such as personnel management, storage area, international distribution, WMS system.
- Warehouse logistics analysis allowing to draw rational conclusions
- Mapped activities that chronologize and queue process optimizations
- Analysis of development prospects in terms of warehouse automation and the warehousing process itself
